In a collaborative effort with Owen Architecture, Workplace Architecture + Design (Workplace A+D) undertook a multifaceted approach encompassing Interior Design and the Federal and State Historic Rehabilitation documentation for the Stuart Motor Company building. Erected in 1926, this historic edifice served as a bustling hub, housing an automobile showroom, garage, and service station for the esteemed Stuart Motor Company. Notably, Mr. Stuart and his family resided in a suite of apartments nestled on the building's second floor. Commencing its restoration in 2007, the renovation initially focused on the rear two-thirds of the structure, now accommodating Coltrane Grubbs & Whatley, PLLC. Retaining a reverence for the building's origins, the interior design accentuated the charm of the brick and steel girder structure, preserving its historical integrity.
