Second Harvest Food Bank, outgrowing its Winston-Salem facility, collaborated with Workplace Architecture+Design to plan, locate, and design their new headquarters. The project aimed to consolidate operations, accommodate growth, and enhance community service, embodying their tagline: Everyone Deserves to Eat. Beginning with detailed programming, Workplace A+D determined facility requirements, ultimately selecting a brownfield site in Whitaker Park for a 140,000 SF state-of-the-art facility. This includes 10,500 SF of culinary space, 95,000 SF of warehousing (with 13,000 SF refrigeration), and 34,000 SF of offices. The design prioritizes flexibility, natural light, and technology, earning the project the NAIOP 2023 Industrial Project of the Year. The non-profit serves Northwest North Carolina, addressing hunger through community-informed improvements guided by diverse organizations and volunteers.
