The project integrates local partners to offer holistic community programs emphasizing arts and wellness for both older and younger adults. The complexity lies in harmonizing multiple organizations within one facility, including the Hispanic League, Novant Health, Winston-Salem State University, Atrium Health Wake Forest-Baptist's Sticht Center, Sawtooth School for Visual Arts, Second Harvest Food Bank of NWNC, and more. Embracing the Main Street Concept, the facility symbolizes a city within a building, providing a diverse range of services for Forsyth County residents.
